Interested candidates can apply for internships and selected interns will work remotely for Manitoban tech companies, allowing youth to stay in their communities and gain work experience. Roles may be flexible to adjust to the skills of those who apply, but employers have shared interest in hiring for roles in social media marketing, email outreach, research, IT support, and development/programming. Internships will run until March 31, 2024. If there is a fit and opportunity, interns may be hired for full time work with the company after the internship.
